

Do Our Brands Have Unclaimed Money With the State?

Checking whether iHeartRaves, INTO THE AM, and EmazingLights are owed any unclaimed property, and the free way to claim it.

Prepared for Will & Brian — June 19, 2026

Scope: company entities only. No personal-name searches. Source context: ABC7 report on California unclaimed property.

TL;DR

- States hold money companies lose track of: uncashed vendor checks, credit balances, refunds to closed accounts, forgotten deposits. California alone holds about **\$15 billion**.
- Checking and claiming is **100% free** on the official state sites. Never pay a finder who offers to recover it for a cut.
- **No verified amounts yet.** The official databases sit behind a verification step, so the live search is still being run. Real figures go in the table below only once confirmed.
- This page is the plan. Will and Brian: confirm the exact legal names so the search catches every record.

Findings

Status: search in progress

No amounts are confirmed yet. The table below stays empty until the official search returns real records. A blank row does **not** mean \$0 found, it means not-yet-searched. Nothing here is an estimate or a placeholder figure.

Unclaimed property is matched on the *exact* registered name, so each brand is searched under every spelling and legal variant. Will, please confirm the exact registered legal names and any prior or dissolved entities.

How we check and claim (free, official only)

California State Controller

claimit.ca.gov

The official California database, the one referenced in the ABC7 report.

MissingMoney (NAUPA)

missingmoney.com

Official multi-state search. Covers California plus other states the companies have operated or banked in.

One warning before anyone acts on this

Never pay a finder or respond to a call/text/email offering to recover unclaimed money for a percentage. Claiming is always free on the two sites above. Paid services just skim a fee off money we are entitled to for nothing.

Questions for Will & Brian

1. Confirm the exact registered legal names for all three entities (plus any prior DBAs or dissolved entities).
2. If we find anything, who owns the filing? Finance (Camille) as a one-time task?
3. Worth making an annual re-check of this database a line in the finance close?
Companies leak uncashed refunds every year.
